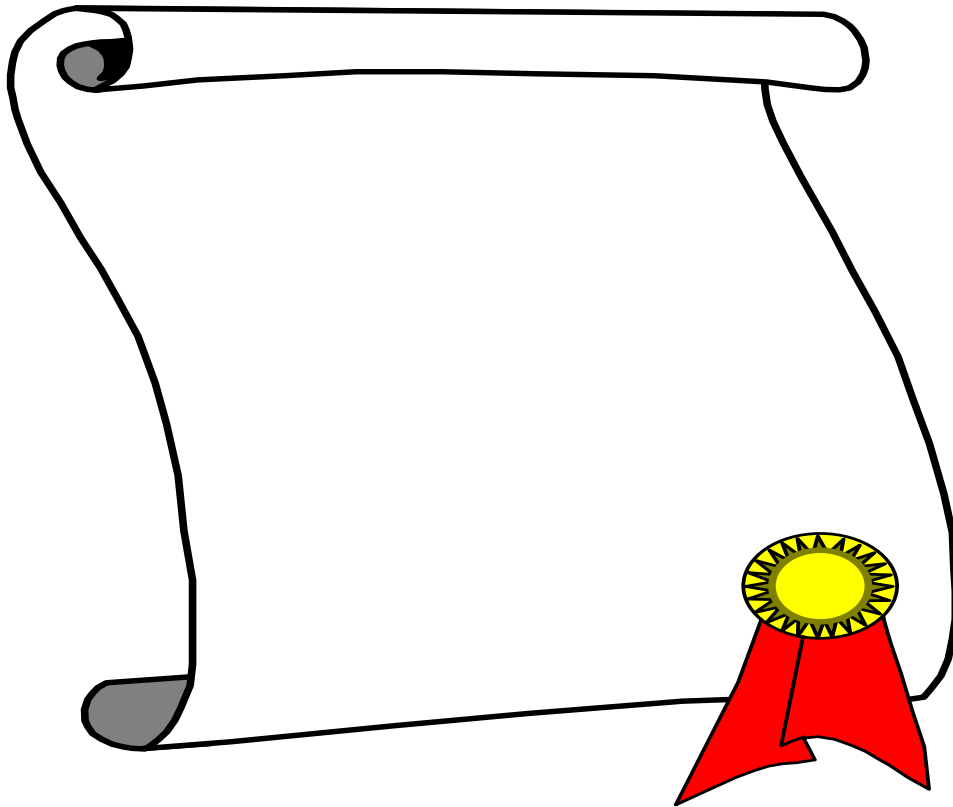


Walter E. Binford, III
Scholarship
Program

THE PROGRAM

The Shore Pop Warner organization has established the Walter E. Binford III Scholarship program to assist former participants who plan to pursue post-secondary education in college or vocational programs. Scholarships are offered each year for full time study at any accredited post-secondary institution of the student's choice.

The Director of the Walter E. Binford III Scholarship program administers the scholarship program. The Director will ensure that the selection process is fair and unbiased and act as an arbitrator when appropriate. The Director will not be a member of the selection committee. Awards are granted without regard to race, color, religion, gender, disability, national origin or financial need.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants to the Walter E. Binford III Scholarship Program:

- Must have participated in the Shore Pop Warner football or cheerleading program for 1 full year.
- Must be graduating High School the year they are applying for the scholarship.
- Must be accepted by post-secondary educational institution prior to application submission.

NOTE: If you have a special circumstance that excludes you from meeting the eligibility criteria, document your reasoning in section 5 of the application for review.

AWARDS

Two scholarship awards of \$1000 each will be granted. One award will be awarded to a former Shore Pop Warner football participant and one to a former Shore Pop Warner cheerleading participant. Awards are not renewable. If the selection committee selects no applicant or no applicant meets the eligibility criteria for that year, the scholarship will not be granted for that year.

APPLICATION

Interested students must complete the attached application and mail it along with a current complete transcript of grades to the Director of the Walter E. Binford III Scholarship Program postmarked no later than May 04, 2009. Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, answer all questions as completely as possible. All information received is considered confidential and is reviewed by only the Walter E. Binford III Scholarship Program selection committee and the Director of the Walter E. Binford III Scholarship Program.

SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of an outside appraisal and or endorsement, academic achievement, Shore Pop Warner participation, participation in school and community activities, honors and or awards, work experience, an essay, as well as the amount of time volunteered to Shore Pop Warner activities while attending High School. Financial need will not be considered.

The Walter E. Binford III Selection Committee will make the selection of the recipients. Applicants agree to accept the decision of the Walter E. Binford III Selection Committee as final. Recipients will be notified by June 01, 2009. Not all applicants to the program will be selected as recipients.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP

Payment of the scholarship will be made by August 31, 2009. The check will be mailed to the recipient's home address and are made payable jointly to the student and the school and must be endorsed by both.

OBLIGATIONS

Recipients have no obligations to the Shore Pop Warner Organization. They are, however, required to supply the Director of the Walter E. Binford III Scholarship program with complete transcripts when requested and to notify the Director of the Walter E. Binford III Scholarship program of any changes of address, school enrollment, or other relevant information.
